## *Christ & Creation*

It is no mistake that the Bible begins with the story of creation in Genesis and ends with new creation in Revelation. “Our end” as the English poet T.S. Elliot famously put it, “is in our beginning.” This class will be an exploration of the doctrine of creation in three parts: (1) Telling the story of creation and new creation, (2) Interpreting the story of creation and new creation and (3) Applying the story of creation and new creation. Throughout the course of this class special attention will be given to the person and work of Christ as the one through whom and for whom all things were created (Colossians 1:15-18)

## *Conversations in Counseling*

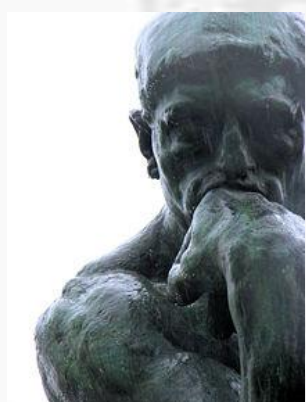

## *Where Shall Wisdom Be Found?*

In Job 28:12, Job asked, "Where Shall Wisdom Be Found?" This class will explore that question in two parts. The first half will introduce the wisdom literature of the Old Testament (the central place where wisdom is found). The second half will survey other places in Scripture where wisdom themes surface (where else wisdom is found). Taken together, this class will show how the diverse landscape of biblical wisdom affects and informs the life of the Christian today.
